

CENTROTEC Sustainable AG – corporate profile

CENTROTEC Sustainable AG, which has its registered office in Brilon, Germany, focuses on the area of energy-saving technologies in buildings. CENTROTEC posted revenue of EUR 480 million in 2010 and expects the figure to reach more than EUR 520 million in 2011. With approximately 3,000 employees worldwide, the CENTROTEC Group is one of Europe's leading players in its field thanks to its innovative energy-saving solutions, and is represented in over 50 countries worldwide. CENTROTEC is listed on the Frankfurt Stock Exchange and has been included in the Deutsche Börse SDAX index since 2008. Its market capitalisation at end of March 2011 was more than EUR 220 million.

CENTROTEC was created in 1998 through modifying conversion of a company that specialising in plastic gas flue systems for modern condensing boilers. From a starting point of EUR 14 million revenue for the predecessor company in 1998, by 2010 the group had grown to a revenue position of EUR 480 million – partly through organic growth and partly through acquisitions based on a strategy of expansion in the areas of health, comfort and energy. Under the umbrella of the CENTROTEC Group, various well-known brands such as Wolf, Ubbink, Brink, Ned Air and Centrotherm have now been brought together, each selling their own products under their separate brand name.

The group is a fully integrated systems supplier of all key technologies for energy conservation and energy efficiency in buildings. As well as ultra-efficient condensing boiler technology, these include most notably systems that use renewable energies, in particular solar thermal, heat pumps and biomass, as well as combined heat and power units. CENTROTEC is furthermore a leading European supplier of ventilation systems with heat recovery, and of gas flue systems for condensing boilers. The CENTROTEC Group possesses key skills and market shares in climate control technology for industrial applications. The company furthermore has an interest of approx. 26 % in CENTROSOLAR Group AG, a company listed on the stock exchange and covering the entire range of products and services for photovoltaic systems.

In response to limited fossil energy resources and the growing pressure to act on climate change, CENTROTEC is addressing the growing demand for energy conservation through innovative systems for building services engineering.
